- This wide network **is co-created and animated by aspirational and leading women** aiming to improve the representation of female leadership within African companies.



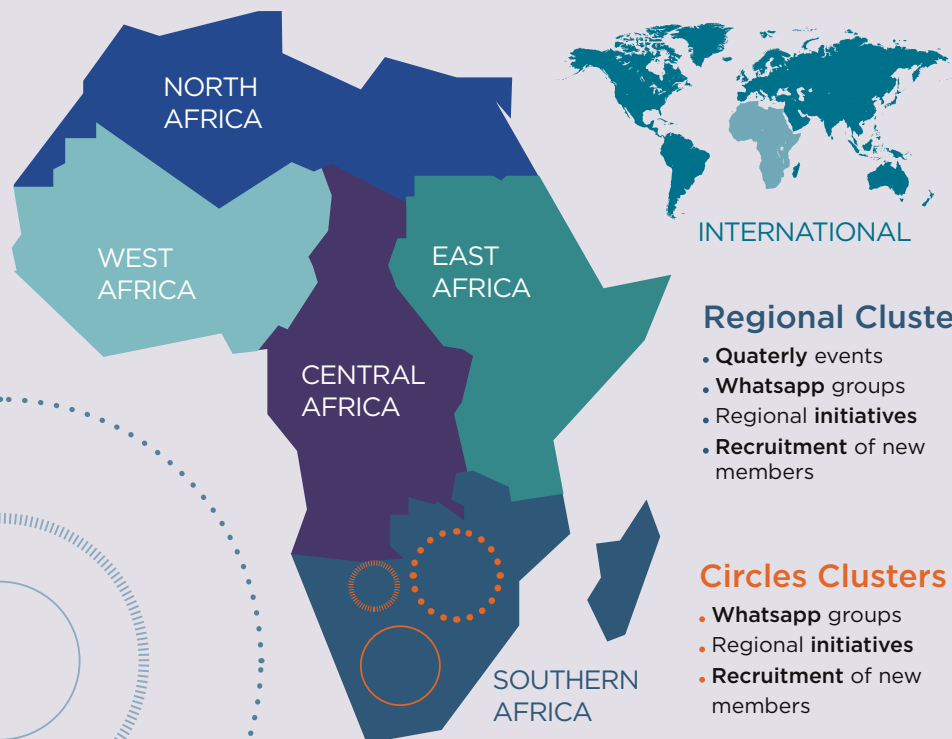


HOW?
